

SCIENCE LABS

To assure safe & secure travel, Sarala Birla Gyan Jyoti Sr. Sec. School has its own fleet of buses designed as per standards and manned by trained & competent drivers. The Transport Service (optional) is managed by the school and a separate transport fee is charged for this. For surveillance and monitoring, a transport attendant is on board throughout the travel along with CCTV surveillance camera and GPS tracker installed in each of the buses. To ensure efficiency in service & communication in case of emergencies, mobile phones have been provided in all the buses.

- The buses will not be going in by-lanes.
- The transport fee has to be paid in four installments. Kindly refer to the fee structure for further details.
- Parents need to follow the timetable given by the transport authority and be available 5 minutes before the scheduled time at the pick-up/drop point to supervise the child. In case of pick-up, the bus will honk 3 times and will not wait any longer at the stop.
- Parents are responsible for supervising their children to/from their designated pick-up/ drop-off point until they board or alight from the vehicle. This may involve crossing roads. School personnel will not assist children to cross roads.
- All possible efforts will be taken to see that the child is handed over to the parent/ guardian while dropping back from school.
- The running time has been calculated to keep it to a minimum and we constantly endeavor to stick to the schedule, but if there are any delays or diversions caused due to traffic congestion/road repairs it will not be the fault of the Management.

OFFLINE CLASS

School Academic Session begins on 1st of April every year and ends on 31st March of the calendar next year. Besides the Summer Vacation, there are 2 short vacations viz. Puja Holidays and the Winter-Break.

The school functions on all days of the week, except on 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month

SCHOOL HOURS

Nursery to Class - I : 8.00 am to 11.30 am Class - II and above: 8.00 am to 02.10 pm

COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS / GUARDIANS

The School emphasizes on involving parents/guardians in the educational progress of their children. Active involvement and unstinted support is solicited for the all-round development of your wards. Parents / guardians must attend the Parent-Teacher Meetings which are held at regular intervals (generally after the examinations). Parents are requested to study the feedback provided by the class teacher with care and consult the school authorities, if necessary.

For their concerns, parents should keep in touch with the Class-teacher of their wards. Class-Teacher is Single-point contact for the parents for all their concerns: may it be academic or administrative.





Admission **GUIDELINES**

- Admission procedure starts from the month of September (for the ensuing academic session) which includes an interaction with the child and the parents (The registration forms and prospectus are available in the school office for the price of Rs 600.)
- Admission for meritorious students from class I to class IX will be allowed only if they qualify the Admission Test.
- The school grants admission in Class XI in three streams viz. Science, Commerce and Humanities.

THE REGISTRATION FORM DULY FILLED AND RECEIVED BY THE SCHOOL OFFICE DOES NOT GUARANTEE ADMISSION IN THE SCHOOL

Forms submitted with the signature of parents / guardian and without a passport size photograph will not be entertained.

CURRICULUM

The School Curriculum has been designed based on the CBSE's recommendations.

Comprehensive Evaluation and improvements are a regular practice apropos the curriculum. This has made it imperative for us to devise the most effective method for the implementation/delivery of the curriculum.

In an academic session, the school has to have 210 working days (apropos CBSE's mandate) out of which 180 days are devoted to intensive teaching and the additional 30 days are set aside for Examinations (Assessments) and co-curricular activities.

The pre-primary wing of the school consists of Nursery, LKG and UKG and works for the needs and demands of early childhood. We heartily believe that the foundation of a child's personality is laid and that two third of his intellect develop at this stage. Therefore, we have created an environment and a system of teaching which is entirely child-friendly. Formal learning of the three Rs is introduced in Play Group & LKG. It finds a more prominent place in the UKG curriculum, which includes recognition, reading and writing of English alphabets and small words and also basic

These are in line with the National Education Policy 2020, wherein for Balvatika, Emphasis is to be given on developing capability in literacy & numeracy.

PRIMARY

The syllabus is comprehensive and more versatile for this level and gradually the young learner is exposed to a wide range of subjects and study materials which are appropriately graded.

In addition to Mathematics, English, Bengali and Hindi; subjects like General Science and Social Science are also introduced. Computer science is introduced in Class-I. Students learn to work on computers in the multimedia lab which has been specially equipped to meet the needs of the young learners.

CLASSES VI TO VIII

Students of class VI to VIII study English, Hindi/Bengali, Sanskrit, Mathematics, Computer Science, Science (covering Physics, Chemistry, and Biology) and Social Science (covering History, Civics, and Geography). Co-curricular activities include Physical and Health education, Work-experience and Art education.0

CLASSES IX TO X

Students from classes IX to X English, Hindi/Bengali, Mathematics, Science (covering Physics, Chemistry, and Biology) and Social Science (covering History, Civics, Geography and Economics) and Information Technology (Skill subject). Cocurricular activities include Physical and Health education, Work experience and Art education.

Classes XI to XII

Students of class XI & XII may opt for Science, Commerce or Humanities stream each of which contains 5/6 subjects.

Science Stream

5 or 6 subjects from the following group are offered-- English Core, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Physical Education and Informatics Practices.

Commerce Stream

Co-curricular activities

5 or 6 subjects from the following group are offered - English Core, Applied Mathematics, Business Studies, Economics, Accountancy, Information Practice, Physical Education.

Humanities Stream

5 or 6 subjects from the following group are offered - English Core, History, Geography, Sociology, Political Science, Physical Education, Applied Mathematics.



The Children from Class-I onwards are divided into four houses- Agni, Jal, Prithvi and Vayu.

Inter House competitions in Quiz, Dance, Singing, Debate, Painting / Drawing, Poster Designing etc. are held on a regular basis. Facilities for Basketball, Badminton, Kho-Kho, Cricket, Football are available. Students are encouraged to participate in all Inter-House competitions and Inter-School competitions, organized by CBSE.


PRIZES
